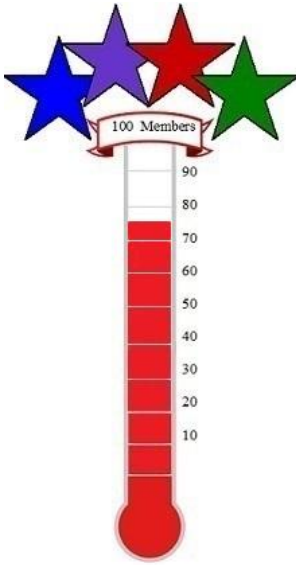

PLEASE NOMINATE A ROAD TEAM CAPTAIN. TENNESSEE ROAD TEAM NOMINATIONS ARE OPEN

Tennessee's Road Team is a statewide highway safety program started with funding from **Bridgestone Commercial Solutions** and supported by the Tennessee Trucking Foundation with major funding from **Pilot Flying J**. The Road Team is composed of professional truck drivers with

superior driving records and a desire to spread the word about safety on the highway. These professional drivers are nominated by their TTA Member companies and selected by a team of judges who evaluate their nomination packages. The drivers who are selected will serve a two-year term as ambassadors for our industry in Tennessee.

Nominations for the 2019 - 2020 Tennessee's Road Team will be accepted through Friday, October 5, 2018. There are 14 Road Team Captains who will be serving their 2nd year along with any new Road Team Captains selected. We would like to select 14 new Captains including more female drivers and team drivers. Drivers who are nominated and meet eligibility requirements will go through a selection/interview process on Thursday, October 11, 2018 in Nashville at the TTA Office. FMCSA HOURS OF SERVICE OF DRIVERS

Following up on FMCSA seeking comment in regards to hours of service of drivers, **the FMCSA has extended the Anprm's comment period to October 10th**. If you are planning on submitting comments, please send me your thoughts in regards to the questions within the enclosed word document by the end of next week, September 28th.

STA'S - IN TRUCK ONLY TOLLS

On behalf of Gary Langston, with the Indiana Motor Truck Association, we are sharing this information with our membership. As you may know, this past Tuesday they were informed, along with the general public, that Gov. Holcomb and the Indiana Toll Road reached an agreement, after secret meetings, to raise toll rates for trucks only by 35% on the Indiana Toll Road. FMCSA SEEKS PUBLIC COMMENT ON REVISING CURRENT HOURS-OF-SERVICE REGULATIONS FOR INTERSTATE TRUCK DRIVERS **PERIOD EXTENDED FOR PROPOSED RULEMAKING ON HOURS-OF-SERVICE**

FMCSA has extended the comment period for its Advance Notice of Proposed Rulemaking on hours of service until October 10, 2018. ATA was one of several organizations to submit an extension request earlier this month.

FMCSA determined that extending the comment period beyond the initial September 24 deadline would allow for more detailed comments to the ANPRM, which was issued on August 24. ATA will submit comments but strongly encourages carriers and drivers to submit their own separate comments, and to respond directly to the questions detailed in the notice.

Comments must be submitted no later than 11:59 PM EST on October 10, 2018, and can be submitted online via regulations.gov.

The U.S. Department of Transportation's Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) today announced that it is seeking public comment on revising four specific areas of current hours-of-service (HOS) regulations, which limit the operating hours of commercial truck drivers.

The upcoming Advanced Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (ANPRM) <https://www.fmcsa.dot.gov/regulations/hours-service-advanced-notice-proposed-rulemaking>, which will be published in the Federal Register, responds to widespread Congressional, industry, and citizen concerns and seeks feedback from the public to determine if HOS revisions may alleviate unnecessary burdens placed on drivers while maintaining safety on our nation's highways and roads. ATRI RESEARCH QUANTIFIES BENEFITS OF HOURS-OF-SERVICE FLEXIBILITY: REDUCED DRIVING TIME AND LOWER COSTS

The American Transportation Research Institute (ATRI) today released the results of a new analysis on the potential benefits of allowing commercial drivers additional flexibility when they take required hours-of-service (HOS) breaks. ATRI utilized empirical truck GPS data to model the application of split rest beyond the current 8 and 2 hour increments allowed under the existing HOS rules. Through this analysis it was found that drivers could spend less time and money, driving the same distances behind the wheel. Click [here](#) for full details.

TRUCKING INDUSTRY ASKED TO RANK TOP CONCERNS

The American Transportation Research Institute, the trucking industry's not-for-profit research organization, today launched the 2018 Top Industry Issues Survey. The annual survey asks trucking industry stakeholders to rank the top issues of concern for the industry along with appropriate strategies for addressing each issue. The survey is in its 14th year and participation by trucking stakeholders has grown each year.

"ATRI's research provides a chance for thousands of trucking industry professionals, from drivers to executives, to weigh in on the most important topics that affect trucking and collectively decide on the best strategies for addressing each. Completing this survey only takes a few minutes, but its impact can be immeasurable," said ATA Chairman Dave Manning, president of TCW, Inc., Nashville, Tennessee.

The results of the 2018 survey will be released at the Annual ATA Management Conference and Exhibition, to be held October 27-31 in Austin, Texas. Industry stakeholders are encouraged to complete the survey available on ATRI's website at TruckingResearch.org.

2018 TANK TRUCK WEEK - WORKSHOPS IN NASHVILLE, TN

The NTTC, U.S. Department of Transportation (U.S. DOT), and Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) co-sponsored workshops are designed to train cargo tank testers and inspectors to comply with current regulations to transport, design, certify, or repair cargo tank trailers. Rates for the workshop are \$375 for members of NTTC, or \$475 for non-members. The two-day workshop runs from approximately 7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. each day. Attendees will receive a 200-page workbook, the 53rd Edition NTTC Bulk Hazmat Compliance Guide, and breakfast and lunch will be served on both days. LEGISLATIVE CORNER – by Dale Allen and Holly McDaniel - Adams and Reese LLP

The Tennessee Trucking Association has purchased a subscription with VoterVOICE. This is an online platform that will allow TTA to engage the legislature on a grassroots level. VoterVOICE will allow TTA to build and launch advocacy groups, track the progress of legislation, mobilize supporters with targeted messages and allow TTA to send newsletters to its members. This platform will help form a more effective grassroots movement with the ability to members to target their legislators. VoterVOICE will be another effective tool in the toolbox to help us achieve our goals at the Legislature. TTA will be testing the system before the end of the year as well. In addition to using as a grassroots tool to educate legislators, it is a goal to also use VoterVoice to interact with TTA's PAC and legislative updates.

This month is the final stretch for campaigns to get out their message before the elections on November 6th, 2018. All of Tennessee's ninety-nine House Seats, eighteen of the thirty-three Senate Seats, and the Governor's seat will be on the ballot next month. At the moment there will be at least twenty-seven new House Members, three new Senators, and a new Governor. Many of the contested races happened in the August primaries but there are a few seats that will come down to the wire this November. There should not be much more turnover but some current members may end up losing their seats. The race for a new House Speaker officially has three candidates as Representative Glen Casada (R), Representative David Hawk (R), and Representative Curtis Johnson (R) have all publically expressed interest in the position. The Republican Caucus will vote on who they would like to nominate in their meeting following the November elections and then an official vote will take place on the House floor next January.

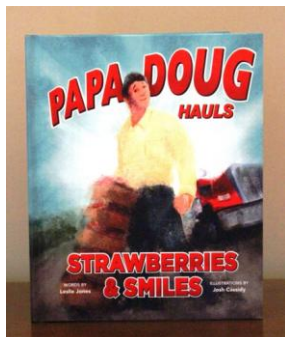

DROWSY DRIVING

Through a grant from the Tennessee Highway Safety Office, we now have a presentation we can make in the workplace for any TTA member at no cost that will provide safety information about how to recognize the signs of drowsiness and how it is a risk to drive without adequate sleep. This information has also been provided on a rack card to all DMV locations across the state and has been approved to go to Welcome Centers as well. There is a Teen version of the presentation that has been incorporated into our Teens and Trucks program for high schools.

SENIOR CITIZENS

Our safety message has also expanded to the driving public who are age 55 and over. This group of drivers has now become one of the age groups with the highest number of fatalities in automobile accidents in Tennessee. Tennessee's driver license renewal laws do not attempt to identify, evaluate nor regulate older drivers whose driving habits and abilities may be deteriorating as they age. Tennessee Trucking Foundation proposes to address the growing need to help Tennessee's older drivers polish their driving skills, increase awareness of their changing abilities, and learn to adapt their driving practices accordingly, especially around large trucks. Part of the approach will be to educate them about the difference in operating a big truck and an automobile, and how that knowledge can impact them on the roadway. The objective will be to prevent fatalities by positively impacting driving behavior.
